



Peter Fromherz is a director at the Max Planck Institute for Biochemistry in Martinsried/Munich and professor for Experimental Biophysics in the Physical Faculty of the Technical University Munich. He completed his PhD in Physical Chemistry in 1969 at the University Marburg. Subsequently, he lead a research group at the Max Planck Institute for Biophysical Chemistry in Göttingen. In 1981 he became a full professor for Experimental Physics at the University Ulm. Since 1994 he is a scientific member of the Max Planck Society. His present interests are the interfacing of semiconductor chips with neuronal systems and the development of voltage-sensitive dyes for brain research.
