Angela Hullmann studied economics with focus on economic policy and economics of developing countries at the University of Göttingen, Germany. After her diploma, she worked at the Fraunhofer Institute for Systems and Innovation Research in Karlsruhe on empirical analyses of technical change. At this time, she received her PhD from the University of Göttingen on international knowledge transfer in nanotechnology.

Since 2001, she works at the Research Directorate general of the European Commission in Brussels, first as Scientific Officer in the area of socio-economic research, since 2003 as Programme Officer in the unit of nanosciences and nanotechnologies. Main areas of her work are – next to programme definition, project evaluation and project management - the analysis of economic aspects of nanotechnology development (such as financing, standardisation, patents) as well as supporting the public dialogue on chances and risks of nanotechnology.
